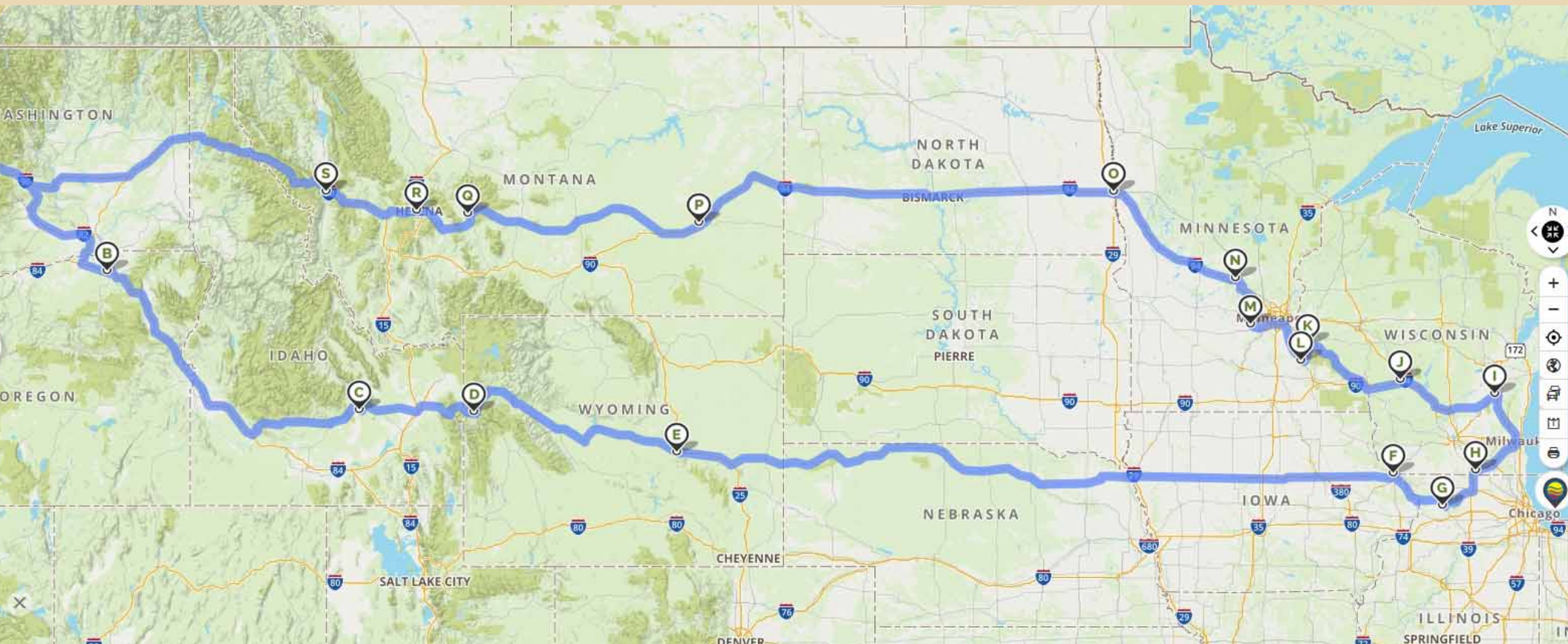

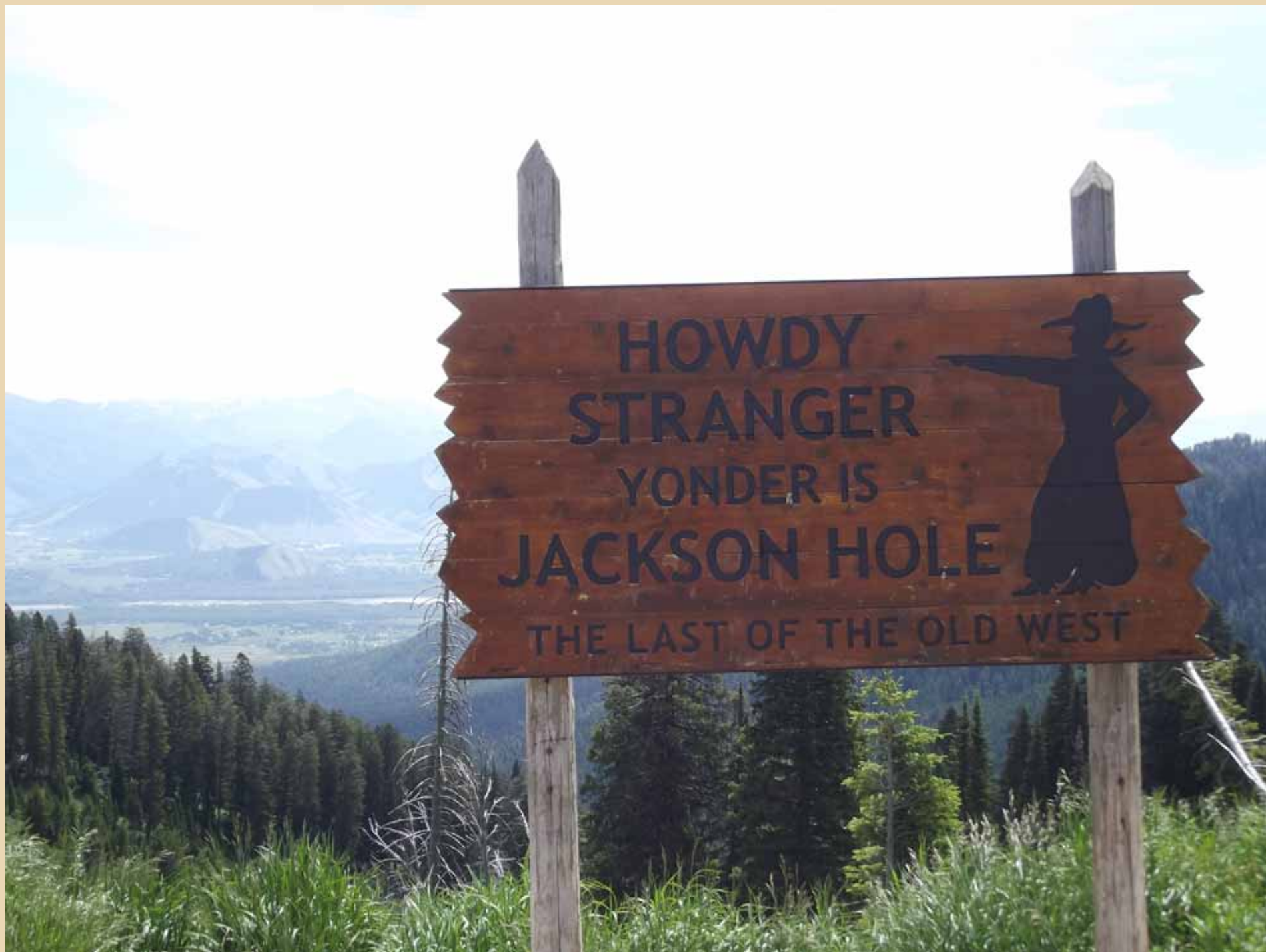

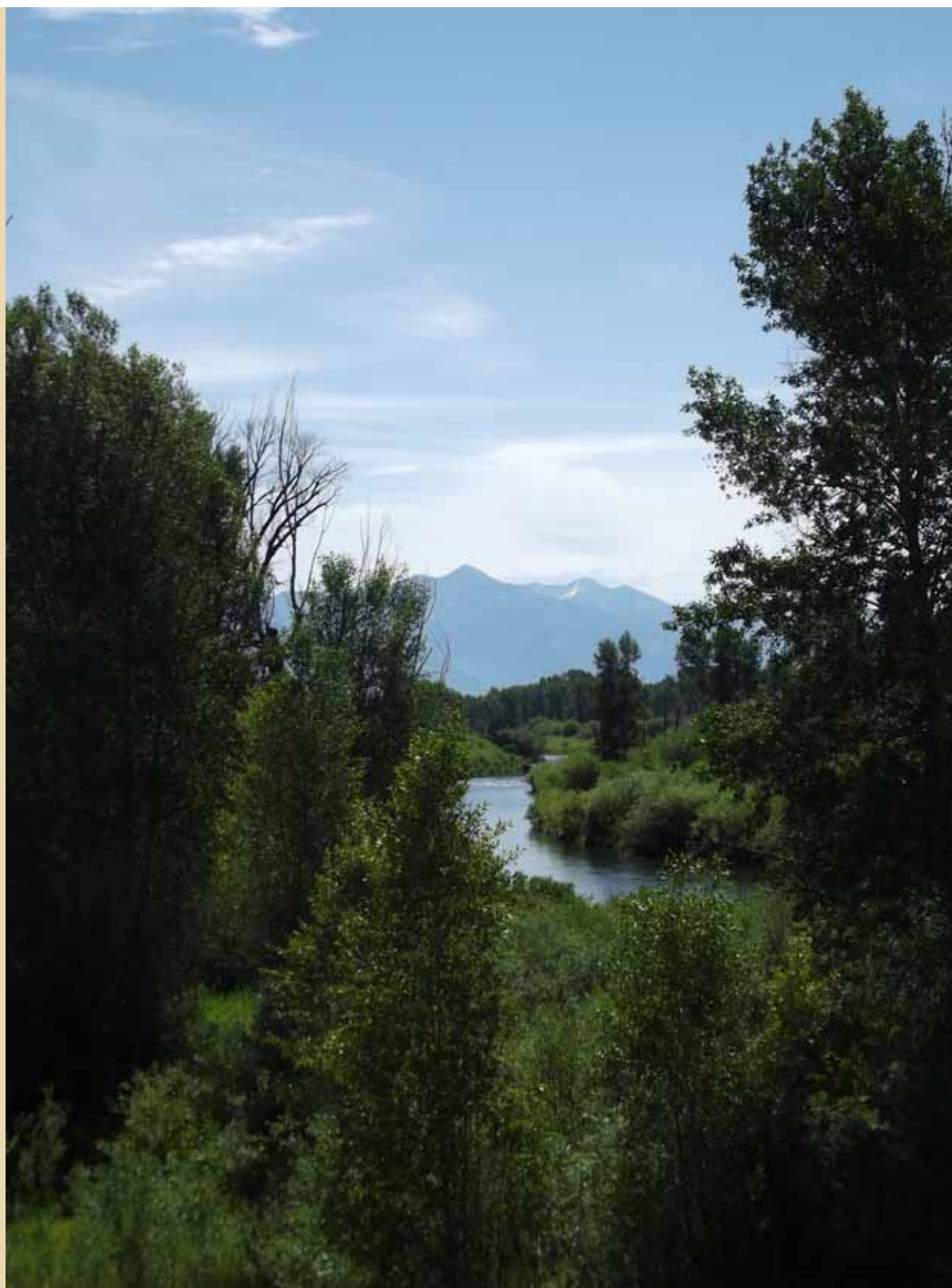
Craters of the Moon National Monument
